- National Virtual Library project.
- Appointment of university librarians in the nine new Federal Government universities.
- Retirement age of university librarians.
- Development of partnership in other areas of mutual interest and benefits.

At the end of the meeting, a committee was set up to develop a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between LRCN and NUC.
